

Eligibility and documents required for OBC scholarship.

Minutes of meeting

- Decision about value of scholarship which will be welfare department approximately Rs.6000 pa per student. Hostel charges also paid in OBC scholarship, if any.
- Discussion about eligibility of applicants that they should be passed with 50% marks in all previous classes or semesters.
- ✤ Applicant need following documents for OBC scholarship:
 - Caste (OBC) certificate.
 - Matriculation certificate (Photocopy).
 - Passport size photographs.
 - Certificate of domicile of Punjab.
 - Student's Adhaar card.
 - Parent's Adhaar cards.
 - Bank passbook (Photocopy).
 - Gap certificate, if any (Attested by Notary Public).
 - Income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 1,00,000/-per Annum (Attested by Tehsildar).
 - In father less case, student can apply through mother's income certificate. In case of death of both mother and father, student can apply through guardian. The guardian has to give the affidavit.
- Discussion about how to inform students about this scholarship.
